INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL LONG DISTANCE SERVICES

This agreement entered into this _____ day of _____ 2003, by and between
Namada and _____, referred to as ASSOCIATE.

Whereas, Namada, acting as Master Agency for United World Telecom, is engaged in the business of providing long distance services to business customers and whereas, ASSOCIATE is desirous of performing sales and services under the following conditions:

1. ASSOCIATE will operate as an independent contractor under this or other written or oral agreements.
2. ASSOCIATE may accomplish his/her work at places and times of ASSOCIATE'S choice.
3. ASSOCIATE is not an employee of Namada and is not subject to any of the usual rules of employment.
4. ASSOCIATE agrees to pay all of his/her own expenses incurred in this endeavor. Examples of this are business cards, stationary, postage, transportation, entertainment, etc. ASSOCIATE agrees to accept the commission payments in full settlement for all services and expenses, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.
5. ASSOCIATE agrees to obtain all completed forms required by Namada and to complete certain forms and reports related to a sale or sales activity as may be required from time to time by Namada.
6. Provided that Namada has been paid by vendor, Namada shall pay Associate a commission for its' customer orders according to the following terms:

Note: If after 90 days your total usage for clients is NOT more than \$500 Namada has the right and will exercise that right to discontinue commission payments. [Services are intended only for those serious about making money in international services]

ASSOCIATE will be paid commissions based on payments made from ASSOCIATE'S clients for **United World Telecom**

- 12% for all associates whose monthly volume is under \$1,000
- 14% for all associates whose monthly volume is between \$1,001 and \$3,000
- 15% for all associates whose monthly volume is between \$3,001 and \$7,500
- 16% for all associates whose monthly volume is between \$7,501 and \$15,000
- 17% for all associates whose monthly volume is between \$15,501 and \$20,000
- 18% for all associates whose monthly volume is over \$20,001

Payments are made in US dollars and are sent using PayPal.com. If you are in a country that is not serviced by PayPal.com and you do NOT have a bank in a country that does a check will be postmarked to you. Such payments are in no way to be construed as salaries or employee compensation subject to social security, unemployment tax, or workmen's compensation insurance coverage.

7. ASSOCIATE may hire employees or other independent contractors to sell Namada products and services. All payments made from ASSOCIATE to its employees or its independent contractors will be made from commissions listed in item 6.
8. ASSOCIATE agrees to repay to Namada any commissions received on moneys that are required to be repaid to the ASSOCIATE's clients due to accounting error or other unforeseen irregularity.
9. Namada and ASSOCIATE agree that either party can terminate this contract thirty (30) days after written notice of termination is received. **All commissions due and payable will continue for the life of the accounts provided that total sum of all accounts exceeds \$500 monthly.**
